

**Yayasan Bina Usaha Lingkungan (YBUL) in Cooperation with  
PlaNet Finance and TransEnergie Held National Workshop  
On Solar Photo Voltaic Development in Indonesia; Going to a Sustainable Model**

*Jakarta-19 June, 2008.* A one-day workshop organized by Yayasan Bina Usaha Lingkungan (YBUL), in coordination with PlaNet Finance and TransEnergie under the RENDEV project, was attended by more than 40 key players in renewable energy fields and microfinance in Indonesia.

The workshop was established in Kencana Room Sari Pan Pacific Hotel, Jakarta. The participants are from Government Bodies: Directorate General for Electricity and Energy utilization (DGEEU) Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resource, PLN (national electricity company), BP2TE and PTKKE BPPT (Agency for Research and Application of Technology), financial institutions: ADB, Bank BNI, Bank Danamon, Non-Government entities: Ekonid, Habitat for Humanity, Pelangi Indonesia, IIEE, WWF Indonesia, Private sectors: Citrakaton Dwitama, Sundaya Indonesia, Sharp Electronic Indonesia, Total ESP, Guna Electro, Suar Intermuda, LEN Industry, and Gema, and also from media: AN-TV.

The workshop is aimed to raise awareness of actors in the micro finance and renewable energy sector on the advantages of collaboration in solar PV development in Indonesia and further, to define a workable framework for the Indonesia solar industry as well as a workable scheme for going to a sustainable model.

Three consecutive sessions were taking all the participants sharpening the discussion to the aimed focus. An informative presentation delivered by the Director for New and Renewable Energy-DGEEU Ministry of Energy and Mineral Resource Indonesia on the first session, was followed by discussion and presentations of example models on financing support for Solar PV development; study cases in Sri Lanka, Bangladesh and Morocco/Senegal, on the second session. On the last session, a constructive discussion was focusing on potential workable model for Indonesia to be developed now and in the future that afford to ensure the sustainability in fields. The workshop came up with conclusion which was then submitted to the Government as a valuable input for policy making in Solar PV development in Indonesia.
